Providing a voice for inclusive multicultural school environments!

Create an opportunity for stakeholders (Parents, Students, and Staff) to come together to develop and address inclusive structures to meet the needs of all students. Eliminate inequities in the educational system to ensure equally high outcomes for all participants, removing the predictability of success or failure that currently correlates with other factors.

The CEIP will examine and address issues related to inequity and identify solutions, including:

- Elimination of policies, practices, attitudes and cultural messages that reinforce different outcomes
- Fostering a safe and healthy school climate
- Promoting an inclusive culture that engages and draws on the assets of students, families, staff and community members
- Encouraging conversations about equity and social justice

The work of the CEIP will directly reflect the priorities of the community and the participating school sites. School sites will identify stakeholder-specific teams, such as student, family, and/or staff.

- Members will engage in self-reflection and growth, enhance organizational leadership and structures for equity and develop and enact an equity vision.
- Members will work to identify and understand equity-related issues, set priorities, raise awareness through intentional communication and feedback loops, take action, measure progress, and adjust strategies to promote inclusive education.
